Instructional Coaching: At Holy Angels we believe excellence happens on purpose and adult actions determine scholar outcomes. To ensure excellence and scholar outcomes a new instructional framework and accompanying coaching guide was developed by the NDAA leadership team. This framework is an important next step in the work to put all our scholars on the path to college. The framework describes a set of foundational actions in three core domains of teaching and learning: classroom culture, objective mastery, and rigor and engagement. It also provides a shared definition of effective instruction and a common language for discussing teacher practice. This framework is not designed to be a checklist, but rather a first step in ensuring that all our teachers are experts in the foundational actions needed to establish a positive classroom culture, ensure all scholars develop mastery of grade-level content, and engage scholars in rigorous and authentic reading, writing, and discussion.

Big 3- The Big 3 are essential pieces of our scholars becoming responsible and respected individuals. The following are our Big 3:

Growthwork- items our scholars are expected to complete at an assigned date. This helps create an understanding of deadlines and completing tasks in a timely fashion.

On time: showing up and on time are vital for our scholars success now and in the future. See section below about tardies and absences.

Dress code: our scholars are expected to be in a neat and clean uniform everyday. Being dressed for success creates an image and mindset of success.

Tardies/Absences- For your scholar(s) to be as successful as possible, it is important that they are on time each day and stay the entire day. Getting scholars to school on time and picked up on time are an expectation of parents attending Holy Angels Catholic School. Late arrivals are a disruption to the learning environment and put the scholar arriving late at a disadvantage. Appointments should be made outside of school hours whenever possible. It is really difficult for scholars to make up the discussions/teaching that happened while they were gone. Our before care begins at 6:30 am.

CLINIC REMINDERS

With flu season here please keep in mind the following:

Frequent hand washing with soap and water is the best way to prevent cold and flu.

Free flu shots are available at local pharmacies.

The clinic at Holy Angels is stocked with Tylenol, Ibuprofen and cough drops. Your scholar may receive these on an as needed basis as long it is indicated on their medical info sheet.

Parents may provide cold and flu medicine to be kept in the clinic for symptom relief. Please drop off the medicine to the nurse and sign the authorization form.

If your scholar experiences illness, please remember they must be fever free/vomit free without medication or 24 hours on antibiotics to be at school. We would not want to spread germs and make others sick, healthy kids learn best!
