August 10 - 1st day of school.

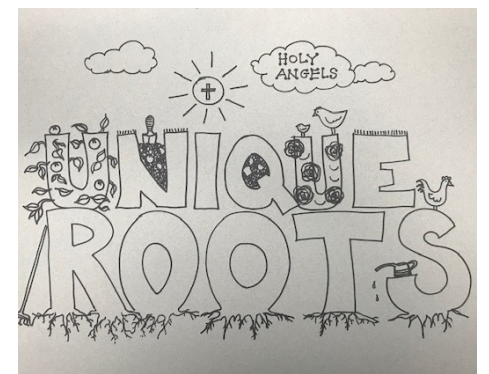
OUR PARTNERS
