For years I have had a sign in my office that reads, "You don't need a cape to be a hero, you just need to care." This year our heroes will have masks and shields though and, as always, they will care for and love the scholars that come through our doors on August 10 and every day throughout the school year.

Above is the Marion County Public Health Departments guidance for in-person learning. All decisions for in-person learning will be based off the percent positivity rate. This rate is the average of the most recent 7 days positivity percentages in Marion County. Over the last couple of weeks Marion County has had a positivity rate of around 9%. Based on the guidelines provided Holy Angels can provide in-person learning up to a 12% rate. As you can see from the other chart above, on the right, Marion County has not even reached an 11% positivity average in the last two weeks and has been on a steady decline.

At Holy Angels we have taken many steps to ensure our school is prepared for scholars to join us again for in-person learning. Some of these are updates to our original reopening plan. Here are some of the highlights:

- All individuals that enter our building are required to wear a mask.
- We are providing all teachers with 5 masks and a face shield.
- All scholars will be provided with 10 masks and a face shield. (3 grade – 6 grade required to wear masks).
- We have purchased an Emist disinfecting cart and two disinfecting foggers.
- All high touch areas will be disinfected on a daily schedule.
- We increased the number of hand sanitizing stations throughout the school.
- All scholars will have assigned seating in the classroom and cafeteria.
- Numerous hours have been dedicated to a deep clean of the entire school; from the vents to the floors.

We will continue to work closely with the Marion County Health Department to provide safe and healthy learning.



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
