RightFit is a coalition of students, parents, educators, sponsors, public safety personnel and committed volunteers who choose to work together to enhance a safer and healthier community. RightFit provides our scholars after-school programming that encourages academic growth, fun physical activity, and a nutritious meal.

These program segments take between 30-60 minutes, and Holy Angels works diligently to mix and match scholar after-school schedules with optimum program performance time periods. RightFit partners with public safety personnel, university students and other volunteers to assist with programming.

The Indiana State Police, the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department, the IMPD Cadets, the Indiana Department of Corrections, Purdue Extension, Marian University Literacy Program, Anthem, and the Marion County Prosecutor's Office will be participating in 2021-22. Students from IUPUI, Ivy Tech, Marian University, and the University of Indianapolis receive service learning credit by volunteering for RightFit. The short-term benefit from these volunteers is that scholars receive growthwork help and see academic improvement. In the long-term, positive relationships develop between our scholars and public safety officials, and scholars are exposed to mentors who are college students, which hopefully can impact their mindset of what is possible in life, reaching college and heaven.
