

HOLY ANGELS FILM DEBUT



IEARTLAND INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL





Over the last few years a film crew from Los Angeles has been creating a documentary about the work of Stephen Ritz, founder of the Green Bronx Machine. *Generation Growth* takes a journey across the country to address the social determinants of health in some of the most vulnerable communities through an interactive gardening curriculum that allows scholars to grow fruits, vegetables and herbs in the classroom and teaches them healthier eating habits. This curriculum creates greater engagement with school and allows children to harvest hope. Holy Angels is one of the featured schools in this documentary, which will premiere at the Heartland International Film Festival in Indianapolis on Sunday, Oct. 11, 2020 at 7:15 p.m. at Tibbs Screen 2. The Heartland International Film Festival is Indiana's largest and longest-running film festival and will celebrate its 29th anniversary this October across Indianapolis. Since the inaugural Festival in 1992, Heartland has grown to an 11-day celebration featuring more than 100 independent films. The Holy Angels team is also working on another viewing opportunity for our families, scholars, and community.
