Two years after Stephen Ritz brought Green Bronx Machine to Holy Angels and other schools across America the documentary which is focused on healthy and educational outcomes in low-income areas is taking home awards.

In October, *Generation Growth* was named the winner of the Viewer's Choice and Indiana Spotlight awards at the Heartland Film Festival.

The film takes a journey across the country to address the social determinants of health in some of the most vulnerable communities through an interactive gardening curriculum that allows students to grow vegetables in the classroom, helping them eat better, be more engaged with school and give them pathways for jobs.
